Winter Shelter/Meal Distribution:

Due to COVID-19, AAHART's Winter Shelter was unable to collect enough sites to host a winter shelter. The plan this year is to host a **Seven times Seven** event where each group or congregation would sign up for a day of the week to be responsible for 30 meals on that day for seven weeks (for example, St. Matthews has every Wednesday for seven weeks). The group/congregation is also responsible for distributing the meals (AAHART can assist you with locations if needed). Arden Arcade HART might be able to assist financially, so please do not let that be the only deterrent. Keira Miller and Jim Schaal gave an update on the Seven by Seven meal distribution outreach. Keira created a spreadsheet that records the different locations volunteers have visited and how many meals they delivered at each location. Street Outreach:

Mercy Pedalers are a group that typically rides on bikes to greet and comfort those experiencing homelessness. They offer resources, provide a cup of coffee or a snack, and ask about their needs. There are multiple Mercy Pedalers in the Arden Arcade Area to cover most of the week.

Heather Wheeler is the Navigator for Arden Arcade and Carmichael. Heather's work cell is 916-754-7315. If you meet anyone that needs her services, they can call or visit her office hours. Heather helps those experiencing homelessness get documents ready for housing and other programs: i.e. ID vouchers, proof of income, social security cards, birth certificates, and more. She helps guide clients to obtaining income and job resources. When clients are ready for housing, she will locate housing and send referrals while also supporting the client through the process. Heather is in constant need for resources to support her in Navigation—day bus passes, gas cards, and gift cards from McDonalds/Walmart/Goodwill.

Mercy Pedalers Update: Kathy Stricklin reported that the Mercy Pedalers handed out 180 sack lunches in December and also passed out toiletry bags. Keira Miller is assisting the Mercy Pedalers with outreach. Thank you Keira for volunteering to help.

Navigation: Heather Wheeler is working both in the field and remotely. She continues to meet with clients outside her normal office hours due to not having a space for office hours. Heather is in need of a space to host her office hours. The space needs to have a table large enough to practice social distancing from her clients, needs to be available for a 3-4 hour block, and possibly electricity and Wifi. Heather has reported an increase in calls about hotel vouchers and clients worried about the colder weather.
